A hearty welcome to you all, once more to the Annual Day celebrations of the school. This occasion is a celebration of dedication, perseverance & collective achievement of our students. With your permission I Present the Annual Report for the year.

It gives me immense pleasure & pride to present the annual Report of our institution for the academic year 2025-26. I would like to take this opportunity also to showcase to the audience on the priority areas of our school.

Our school focuses on the Holistic development of the students as mentioned by NEP. We use the Panchanga shikshanam method with which all the five areas of development in a child are focused up on. The school is intent on creating a young generation of students who think creatively, act boldly and contribute relentlessly towards building a culturally rich, harmonious and prosperous nation.

Moving on to the report-

Academic Activities

Education is not preparation for life, Education is life itself. This academic year has been marked by commendable results. Our batch of 23 students appeared for class X board exams- out of which 17 of them got distinction and 6 of them got first class. The school average is 80.67, which is more than State and National average of CBSE. The school conducted 'Honours Day' in the month of June to commemorate the achievement of all toppers . It gives me great pride to State that Geetha N D of class IX – secured the 2nd prize in state level Talent exam held by BVN and she's the only child from Thrissur district to win a State Rank. She also qualified for Indian Olympiad Qualifier in Maths. Rhithwika Lakshmi of class IX secured district level first prize in the Hindi Sugma exam, conducted by Kerala Hindi Prachara sabha.

Last year we introduced HPC in the foundation stage. This year we have taken it the preparatory stage also for classes 3, 4, & 5. The school library has started functioning in a full fledged manner with the assistance of a Librarian . We are planning to convert it to a digital library in the near future, keeping in mind the need of the hour. Four of our class rooms are now equipped with Smart Boards which makes the teaching learning process much simplified and very interesting. Our teaching staff are also continuously upgrading themselves by attending CBPs requisited by CBSE and other training workshops.

Coming to Sports:-

Many of our children did us proud by achieving laurels in the sports field. Vasudev K G of class X won the gold medal in National Archery Championship. Thejus Dev of Class VI won the district level Archery gold medal. Aroma Madhu of Class VII won the state championship in Boxing (Girls) with a gold medal. Athulkrishna of class X , won the bronze medal for Discuss throw at state level BVN Athletics. Bhagath Krishna of 5th std won , 2nd prize at state level for kick boxing & 3rd prize for karate. Yadav C S of class 8 represented Kerala state at both Zonal & National levels of BVN Football championship. Theerthalakshmi E J of LKG secured State, National and Kalams world Record for maximum reverse steps on toe knuckles. Shreya P Ramesh of class 5th has

achieved State & National Records for creating miniature artefact of a boat (2.5 cms).

Jaikrishna Jagjit of class 7th has won gold medal in WAKO kerala kick boxing state championship & Bronze medal in shotokan National karate championship

Apart from this, coming to Arts arena - Our school with all our limitations took part in the BVN kalamela and was placed 9th among the 32 CBSE schools in the district. For the first time the school participated in the Sahodaya kalotsav and most of the participating students secured an A grade with Geetha N D of class IX securing 2nd prize with A grade for Malayalam Essay writing.

Celebrations-

Just as much as we focus on high quality education we are also bound to inculcating values such as discipline, empathy, leadership qualities and social responsibility amongst our children.

As part of this festivals like Gurupurnima, Ramayana month, Rakshabandhan, Onam,, Navarathri etc.. were celebrated with due importance & gaiety. Socially relevant events like environment day (observed with Vriksha pooja) Kargil day , Independence day, Reading day , Teachers day, kerala piravi,

Childrens day & world food day were also celebrated with great enthusiasm & vigour.

Counseling & Mental well being

As we all know, Mental well being is one of the important areas of focus as per CBSE. Considering that, our school has an in house Counsellor who comes on a weekly basis to help the students in need. This year we conducted 2 programmes by Swami Anand Chaitanyaji for Middle School & High school students. The sessions were on 'focus & attention', as well as 'overcoming exam fear', respectively. We plan to follow this up by holding a session for Class X on stress management after reopening. An Anti-Drug Awareness class was also conducted for Classes VI, VII & VIII.

Tours & excursions .

This year, also the school organized tours and field trips for children from KG Classes to Xth std.

Classes IX & X went to Ooty. Classes VII & VIII went to Nelliampathy. Classes I & II went to Vazhani & Cheppara. The KG section went to Seashore and Classes III, IV, V & VI are set to go to Palakkad just after reopening.

Last but not the least, this is a year that saw significant development in the infrastructure area, which includes upgraded classrooms, an excellently done courtyard with school ground,

and a state-of-the-art turf. A special mention of gratitude to the Management for their persistent efforts in enhancing the facilities of the school.

As I end my annual report, I place on record my sincere gratitude to our management for their constant support and vision, also to everyone who has helped in the smooth functioning of our school — the esteemed members of the Vidyalaya Samiti, Mathru Samithy, Kshema Samithy.
